Honorary Board Members

Honorary Members of the Board help the Early Learning Coalition to achieve its mission, by supporting the work of the organization and acting as an ambassador on its behalf.

ELC Honorary Board members have diverse backgrounds and are leaders, public figures, philanthropists, and/or other influential individuals who are uniquely positioned to be successful advocates and ambassadors for the organization, are passionate about the importance of early learning and support the Coalitions mission and vision. Honorary Board members assist the ELC in creating opportunities for raising funds, friends, and awareness of ELC services and programming through members network of contracts and/or exposure in the community.

This is an honorific title in recognition of the member's active participation, financial contribution or assistance fundraising and/or friend raising, or commitment to bring awareness of ELC's services and programs to the community. While these members have no voting power, they are a vital member of the Board.

Responsibilities of the Honorary Board Member

- Commit to service a minimum of X years, and attend X meeting each year
- Contribute a minimum of \$X a year
- Recruit other Honorary Board Members
- Permit recognition on ELC's website and printed materials

Benefits of Serving
