#### **Eligibility Requirements**

- Head Start children must be 3-or 4-years-old on or before September 1, 2020.
- Early Head Start accepts pregnant women and children birth to 3-years-old.
- Family income must be at or below the US Department of Health & Human Services Poverty Guidelines to qualify for the program.
- Applications must be completed by parent/guardian ONLY.

#### **Documents Needed To Apply**

- Proof of age (child's ORIGINAL birth certificate or foreign passport)
- Proof of guardianship, if applicable
- Parent/guardian photo identification (FL Drivers License or Passport)
- Proof of Broward County residence (domicile)
- Proof of ALL HOUSEHOLD INCOME FOR PREVIOUS **CALENDAR YEAR (2019) OR PAST 12 MONTHS**

#### Applicants must have all documents for the in-person interview portion or the application will not be processed. Please see below for a list of documents and acceptable forms of income

- 2019 Pay stubs with year-to-date income (for full year)
- 2019 W-2 Forms (for full year)
- **Unemployment Compensation Records**

- Veterans benefits records
- Child Support/Alimony records
- Worker's Compensation records
- Military allotment records
- Training stipends
- Grants, fellowships, scholarships
