CEO Report	CEO Renee Jaffe announced that DEL released \$40M for School Readiness funding gaps on January 21, with ELC Broward receiving \$6M, resolving the projected FY25 deficit.  Ahead of the 2025 Florida Legislative session, ELC Broward and AELC are advocating for a \$17M increase in School Readiness funding and a shift to State Median Income (SMI) as the eligibility benchmark.  On January 28, 2025, ELC Broward was named a finalist in two categories at the 14th Annual Community Care Plan Non-Profit Awards. The awards ceremony will be held on March 7, 2025. We would like to extend our sincere gratitude to Board Member Zachary Talbot for his generous donation and assistance with funding our table.
