PRC254RB1 - School Readiness Enrollment/Redetermin ation Update (Goal 1 of Strategic Plan)	Amy Moore provided an update on School Readiness enrollment and redetermination efforts. Since the last Program Review Committee meeting, the Department of Education's Single Sign-On (SSO) update on March 20 caused a significant state-level system disruption. While downtime was expected to last one day, the EFS MOD portal remained unstable for more than two weeks. During this period, daily call volume doubled, in-office traffic increased, and several deadlines were extended. Despite these challenges, 476 new children were enrolled in Q3, and 386 in April, positioning us for a strong Q4.		
	As of May 8, 2025, the wait time from application approval to funding notification is just under two months. The May 7 waitlist pull included applications approved through March 19, with 856 children currently on the list. Q3 attrition averaged 25%, with 75% of the 5,316 children due for redetermination remaining in service. A new survey launched in March is collecting feedback from families who lost services to identify opportunities for process improvements. SR PLUS enrollment stands at 26 children, with Broward continuing to rank among the top coalitions statewide. Families are also being transitioned from the Vulnerable		
	Population program into School Readiness as CSC has approved additional child care funding.		

Looking ahead, recent legislation will raise the School Readiness income eligibility threshold to 55% of the State Median Income (about \$53,000 for a family of four), and new co-payment rules will take effect. Enrollment strategies will be adjusted to align with these policy changes.

Chair Maria Hernandez inquired about the percentage of families unable to complete their redetermination due to incomplete submissions and asked what efforts are in place to assist them in completing their applications.

Amy reported that the organization operates a full-service call center, receiving 350–600 calls daily, with trained customer service specialists assisting parents with redeterminations over the phone. In-person support is also available through trained family services staff. Outreach efforts include email alerts, text messages, and phone calls, with a minimum of three contact attempts per family (at least one by phone), often exceeding this minimum. Data shows that most terminations involve schoolaged children rather than those aged 0–5, and many families leaving no longer require services.

Krystie Castillo inquired about the appropriate DCF contact for parents seeking referrals for families in need of immediate assistance. Amy responded that the case must involve an open abuse or neglect investigation through DCF, and the DCF protective investigator determines which services should be assigned to the child.

 PRC254RB2- VPK Enrollment Update (Goal 2 of Strategic Plan)

VPK Enrollment

Amy Moore provided updates on VPK. As of May 9, 2025, 14,319 school-year VPK applications and 366 summer applications have been approved for the 2024–2025 program year, with 12,753 students currently enrolled—just shy of the State's estimate of 12,815 participants.

The Broward County School District has opened applications for the 2025 VPK Summer Bridge program, a statewide initiative for children needing additional support for kindergarten readiness. The 24-day program (100 instructional hours) runs June—July and serves children who scored below the 10th percentile on PM3 or were designated as "assessment inappropriate," "failed practice," or "non-English speaker."

For the 2025–2026 program year, 8,037 school-year VPK applications and 64 summer VPK applications have been approved to date, keeping pace with last year's totals.

Education & Quality:

Allison Metsch reported on Education and Quality. The Early Learning Coalition hosted its first in-person early childhood conference since the pandemic at Boyd H. Anderson High School on February 22, 2025. The event was a great success, with approximately 560 attendees, 25 workshops presented by ELC education staff and community partners, and 14 vendor tables. Key partnerships included the Department of Health (Vaccinations, KidCare, Tobacco Prevention), Early Steps, Children's Services Council, and The Journey Institute, among others. The event received overwhelmingly positive

feedback, thanks in large part to the enthusiasm and hard work of ELC staff across multiple departments. Special thanks were extended to Laurie Sallarulo for speaking and to the board members who attended.

Renee Podolsky thanked Allison and shared that her staff had expressed positive feedback and appreciated the opportunity to participate.

Help Me Grow Florida

Help Me Grow Florida has hired a Care Coordinator, meeting contractual staffing requirements. The new staff member has completed training and onboarding. The program has begun participating in outreach events, including School Resource Fairs, Countdown to Kindergarten, and monthly Community Care Corner sessions for families attending health appointments. The first "Books, Balls, and Blocks" developmental screening event was scheduled for May 15 at the Walter C. Young Resource Center in Pembroke Pines, with a second event planned for June.

CLASS (Classroom Assessment Scoring System) Update

School Readiness

As required by the Division of Early Learning, all ELCs use the CLASS (Classroom Assessment Scoring System) tool to assess School Readiness (SR) providers with more than 20% SR enrollment or a CLASS 1 violation. The tool measures teacher—child interactions and classroom management, with 50% of each care level observed. Providers receive a composite score between 1 and 7; those scoring below 4.0 cannot contract with the ELC.

To date, 966 of approximately 1,000 SR observations have been completed, with a current countywide average score of 5.51.

Voluntary Pre-Kindergarten (VPK)

Since July 2022, the Division of Early Learning has required all VPK classrooms, including public-school classes, to be observed using the CLASS tool during both the school year and summer. While no payment differential is tied to VPK CLASS scores, all classrooms are observed. To date, 831 of approximately 900 observations have been completed, and all scores are expected to be finalized on time. The current countywide VPK CLASS average is 5.59.

VPK Performance Accountability Update

The new VPK provider progress monitoring system holds providers accountable for delivering quality instruction that supports children's growth and readiness for kindergarten. School-year programs assess students three times using the Florida Assessment of Student Thinking (FAST) Star Early Literacy: PM1 (first 30 days), PM2 (midyear), and PM3 (final 30 days). Summer programs assess at the beginning (PM1) and end (PM3). These assessments guide programs in directing resources to support students prior to kindergarten.

A school's designation is based on:

- Quality Classroom Instruction CLASS Composite Program Assessment Score (50%)
- **Child Achievement** Percentage of children demonstrating kindergarten readiness on PM3 (20%)

Learning Gains – Growth of 12+ points from PM1 to PM3 (30%)

Using 2022–2023 VPK data for reference, the majority of schools met or exceeded expectations, with higher CLASS scores correlating with higher program designations.

Learning Technology Update

As reported at the last three PRC meetings, the ELC contracted with Age of Learning, Inc. and Marco Polo Learning to enhance VPK children's learning. Analysis of Progress Monitoring 1 (first 30 days) and Progress Monitoring 2 (midyear) data shows that VPK sites using either vendor's tools scored higher than sites using neither. Sites utilizing Marco Polo materials demonstrated the most successful results. The FAST Star Early Literacy is scored on a Unified Scaled Score (USS) from 200–1100, with a score of 707 or higher at PM3 indicating kindergarten readiness.

Ellie Schrot noted she is unfamiliar with the differences between PM1, PM2, and PM3 and suggested creating a "cheat sheet" for the next meeting. Allison agreed.

Amy Hauser asked if there has been any consideration of implementing a uniform monitoring approach to ensure consistency, noting that some directors felt they were scored differently depending on the assessor. Allison responded that to be a CLASS assessor, one must score within a set percentage of the master code. She added that the team conducts frequent double-coding to ensure that different assessors observe and score consistently.

4. PRC254RB4-Outreach/Advocacy Update

Outreach/Advocacy Update

Ancel Pratt provided an update on outreach and Advocacy.

The Communications and Outreach team has intensified efforts to promote VPK enrollment, with the goal of exceeding the VPK Estimating Conference enrollment target for Broward County.

The team has continued strategic advocacy to highlight early learning funding needs and helped organize the upcoming State of Child Care event to engage municipal leaders and local stakeholders supporting ELC's match program.

Digital Advertising & Outreach

- **School Readiness (SR):** Paid advertising resumed in late April 2025, helping to generate 15,298 landing page visitors.
- **VPK:** In April 2025, VPK landing page views reached 13,943, supported by \$800 in paid ads, comparable to April 2024's \$971 spend.

Legislative Advocacy

Launched an advocacy campaign in Dec. 2024 highlighting historical underfunding, including a presentation to the Broward Legislative Delegation with a clear funding goal.

Senate budget proposal includes ELC Broward's requested \$110M base SR allocation; House proposed \$104M, both above last year's \$88M.

	Despite a proposed \$60–80M statewide SR budget reduction, Broward is set to receive the largest increase statewide due to strong performance and advocacy. ELC staff met with legislators during Children's Week to express appreciation and request continued support in final budget negotiations. Maria Hernandez noted that the greatest return on investment has been observed from grocery store posters and gas pump television advertisements. While these options are more expensive, she emphasized that the return is significantly higher.

Background Information:

In FY24/25, we enrolled 6,824 children in School Readiness and locally funded programs, including 3,649 from the waitlist. Despite slowing the pace of enrollments due to budget constraints, we maximized resources to serve as many children as possible. We also processed 19,252 redeterminations, maintaining childcare services for 74% of families. By year end, 1,817 children remained on the waitlist and approximately 14,500 were actively served through our system.

Current Status:

Based on our proposed budget, the target number of children we can serve with the funding allocation is about 14,319. To maintain that level, we need to meet our retention goals and enroll a sufficient number of new children per month from the waitlist. As of August 28, 2025, there are 3,260 children on the waitlist, including 221 currently in care under the Vulnerable Population program. We expect to begin selecting new families soon.

As of August 28, 2025, the wait time from application approval to funding notification is about six months. The earliest application date on the list is March 20, 2025.

For FY25/26, our goal is to retain 75 percent of children through the redetermination process. With only one month of data so far, we are on track. In July, we retained 75 percent of the 1,579 children due for redetermination.

Currently, 72 children are enrolled in the SR PLUS program. The number of families losing services due to income remains low. We will begin tracking attrition for these families when the first group comes up for redetermination in October.

We met with the Children's Services Council (CSC) to discuss the Vulnerable Population childcare program, which continues to be a strong resource for families referred by partner agencies. About 600 children are receiving services, which is higher than expected. In those discussions, we discussed several potential updates to help reduce program costs, including applying the School Readiness copayment scale and limiting the length of time families can remain in the program. CSC will also meet with referring agencies to refine criteria for which families benefit most. As a result, the School Readiness copayment schedule for Vulnerable Population families will be implemented effective September 1, 2025. Once we begin enrolling children into School Readiness again, the census in this program may decrease slightly, though new referrals are expected to continue.

Since the last committee meeting, we fully transitioned to DEL's new copayment policies for School Readiness, effective July 1, 2025. Parent copayments are now set between 3 and 6 percent of gross income for SR and 8 to 10 percent for SR PLUS. Families with multiple children are assessed only one copayment, and only one provider collects it. The next major policy change, coming October 1st, will raise the income eligibility threshold from 150 percent of the Federal Poverty Level to 55 percent of the State Median Income. This increase will grow the waitlist, and depending on available funding, we may not be able to serve higher-income families who qualify under the new threshold.

Background Information:

Florida's Voluntary Pre-Kindergarten (VPK) Program is free for all 4-year-old children living in the State of Florida. During the school year, 540 instructional hours (usually 3 hours per school day) are allotted for VPK learning. While the vast majority of families who take advantage of VPK do so during the school year, Summer VPK is also available in a much smaller number of preschools and School District sites. During the summer, 300 hours are allotted for learning.

For the 2024-2025 program year, we approved 14,305 school-year applications and 519 summer applications. This resulted in 12,755 children enrolled in the school-year program and 315 in the summer program, for a total of 13,070 children in VPK. This exceeded the Florida VPK Estimating Conference projections updated on August 20, 2025, which estimated 11,912 participants combined.

Current Status:

Statewide, VPK participation continues to trend down year after year, with only a slow rebound from Covid and participation well below pre-pandemic levels. Locally, we are down about 400 children compared to this time last year, and approved applications are also down by 1,351. While this may be an early indicator of a lower enrollment year, we remain confident in meeting the estimating conference projection and continue to promote VPK through community outreach and social media engagement.

For the 2025-2026 program year, we have approved 12,389 school-year VPK applications and 95 summer applications. Earlier this year, the Florida Statewide Estimating Conference projected 11,269 participants for Broward. With 9,925 students currently enrolled, additional enrollments still being added, and some programs yet to begin, we are on track to meet that projection.

A. CLASS (Classroom Assessment Scoring System) Update

School Readiness

As required by the Division of Early Learning, all ELC's use the CLASS (Classroom Assessment Scoring System) tool to assess School Readiness (SR) Providers who have more than 20% School Readiness enrolled children and/or those who have received a CLASS 1 violation. The tool looks at the interactions between the children and the teachers, and overall classroom management. We observe 50% of each care level and schools receive a composite score between 1 and 7, any school scoring less than a 4.0 cannot contract with the ELC. A provider may receive an additional Quality Performance Incentive (QPI) differential payment for each enrolled School Readiness based on their score. Scores between 5.0 and 7.0 will receive their respective differentials of 7% and 10%.

We are proud to announce that once again our SR scores are higher than the state average and have increased from the previous school year.

Voluntary Pre-Kindergarten (VPK)

In July 2022, the Division of Early Learning required that all VPK classrooms be observed also using the CLASS tool, both during the school year and summer. We observe every VPK classroom in the county, including our public-school classes. There is no payment differential currently associated with the VPK CLASS score.

We are proud to announce that once again our VPK scores are higher than the state average and have increased from the previous school year.

B. VPK Performance Accountability Update

The new VPK provider progress monitoring holds providers accountable for quality instruction which leads to children learning growth and readiness for kindergarten. To track progress, school year programs test their children three times using the Florida Assessment of Student Thinking (FAST) Star Early Literacy. The first progress monitoring (PM1) occurs in the first 30 days of the program year, progress monitoring 2 (PM2) occurs at the midway point and progress monitoring 3 (PM3) occurs the last 30 days of the program (PM3). In summer, students are tested at the beginning of the program (PM1) and at the end (PM3). Each assessment provides information for the program to prompt support for their students. If students need extra help, the program can direct resources to help them before kindergarten.

This is in combination with the CLASS score and how much growth children demonstrate from PM1 to PM3, determines the school's designation.

- The quality classroom instruction score uses the CLASS Composite Program Assessment Score. (50%)
- The child achievement score is calculated as the percentage of eligible children who demonstrate kindergarten readiness on their progress monitoring 3 (PM3). (20%)
- The learning gains score calculates learning gains as a growth rate of 12 points or more between their PM1 and PM3. (30%)

When we say Broward is the Best, we mean it.

- 77% of our VPK Providers scored at either Excellent or Above Expectations
- 16% of our VPK Providers scored at Meet Expectations
- 5% of our VPK Providers scored with an Incomplete, meaning there wasn't enough data to complete the metric
- 2% of our VPK Providers scored at Below Expectations (9) or Unsatisfactory (2)

We are working with the 7% of providers who scored as Below Expectations, Unsatisfactory, or Incomplete to make sure they comply with the state required Improvement Plan in the hopes of improvement during this year's program.

C. <u>Developmental Supports</u>

Funded through AD Henderson, ELC's Peer Support Specialists provide support for those families who have been referred for an evaluation or further assessment through Child Find. Our Peer Support Specialists supported 908 families through the referral process. More specifically, they spoke to each family, completed the referral form with them, and continued to contact them with reminders, answer questions and connect with them after screenings, evaluations and staffing meetings. Not only can this referral process be daunting for a family, but many are fearful and distrustful of their new reality. With our model of empathy and openness, we were able to make meaningful connections with families, educate them and ultimately, see children benefit. Both FDLRS and Early Steps continually sing the praises of the Peer Support Specialists, as we have seen more families follow through with referral appointments. We have seen the positive results of the work, as demonstrated below.

In FY 24-25, we saw that 57 % of families of children ages birth to 2 followed through with their referral. This is a slight increase from last year which was 55%.

In FY 24-25, we saw that 73 % of families of children ages 3 - 5 years old who have been referred by an Inclusion Specialist, followed through with their referral. This is an increase from last year which was 61%.

D. Help Me Grow

In Fiscal Year 24 - 25, we received funding to facilitate the Help Me Grow initiative in Broward County. We successfully met all our requirements in this first year (in half the time). Through this new opportunity and our continued work in and around the community, we successfully partnered with additional organizations such as Bluebird Kids Health, Ambetter Health, New World Reading and the Greater Fort Lauderdale Diaper Bank. We also expanded our relationships with 211 Broward with the partnership of Help Me Grow as a direct referral source for families to us.

We have our first Books, Balls & Blocks event of the new fiscal year scheduled for Saturday, September 20, 2025 at 10am at Deerfield Beach Community Cares. We have been visiting pediatrician offices weekly and have attended multiple back-to-school events.



E. CDA Academy

We hosted weekly professional development for our CDA Academy and graduated 91 educators last year. The Child Development Associate CDA® is a recognized credential in early childhood education. The CDA® is the best first step on the path of career advancement in the early care and education industry. To achieve the credential, students must have a high school diploma and complete 120 training hours. We have 34 students in our current cohort, completing their 120 hours. For so many of our educators, this is the first positive educational experience for them, and we make sure to celebrate their achievements with graduation ceremonies. Families are invited, and they always attend. Graduates are dressed in cap and gown, and, no graduation happens without some dancing! Stay tuned for information on this group's graduation celebration.

F. Bootcamp

This was our second year for New Educator Bootcamp and we held 3 cohorts, totaling 69 graduates. This is a weeklong training for preschool educators employed for less than 1 year in this field. The school and educator both commit to the educator attending the full week of training. The educator receives a stipend for attending and the provider receives a stipend for the cost of coverage to have one less staff at the school for a week. We have our first session tentatively scheduled for November. We will update you on the date as soon as it is finalized.

Additionally, we will be tracking the following outcomes for our program:

- 1. At the end of the bootcamp, the students will be satisfied and feel that it was a useful/meaningful opportunity.
 - a. Students will share what they liked the best.
 - b. Students will share what they would change.
- 2. After completion of bootcamp, the director will see improved changes in the staff's abilities i.e. by demonstrating an increase in positive interactions with children.
- 3. After 3 months, 6 months and 12 months post bootcamp, staff will still be employed in the field and at the same center.

Background

Early Childhood Educator INCENTIVE\$, formerly known as Child Care WAGE\$® in Florida, rewards early childhood educators with financial incentives based on their education and continuity of employment. By helping to retain the early childhood workforce, INCENTIVE\$ provides children with more stable teacher-child relationships and better educated teachers. INCENTIVE\$ addresses individual professional development efforts and low wages, but does not affect budgets, regular wages, or parent fees within the childcare program.

For over 20 years, the Coalition has partnered with the Children's Forum, the sole licensee in Florida for the North Carolina-Based Child Care INCENTIVE\$® Program as a sole-sourced vendor to administer the program in Broward County. In FY 2022, the INCENTIVE\$ program rolled out a new, higher stipend scale and changed program participation rules to encourage more Directors to support their staff in applying to the program. In FY25, the program currently has approximately 450 active participants from more than 200 childcare centers in Broward. Semi-annual wage supplements range from \$225 up to \$2,500, and the average semi-annual supplement paid is approximately \$750

When stimulus funding became available in 2020, the Coalition more than doubled the funding for the INCENTIVE\$ program to over \$1 million and reduced it down to \$958,974 in FY2025 when the stimulus funding ended.

Current Status

In the absence of the non-recurring stimulus funding and with ELC Broward experiencing reductions to our overall School Readiness funding, staff will be discussing a gradual return to pre-COVID funding levels with the Program Review Committee on September 5, 2025. The decision was made following careful consideration and extensive budget-related conversations taking into consideration which quality/education efforts are core to our mission and current education model.

To accomplish this without disrupting the benefits of existing participants, we propose amending our subrecipient agreement with the Children's Forum to reduce the overall budget by a total of \$250,000 in FY 2026 as follows:

Background Information:

The Communications and Outreach team continues to drive awareness and engagement across all core programs while advocating for sustainable funding for School Readiness. With the FY 2025–26 base allocation set at \$97 million—below both the Senate's proposed \$110 million and the House's \$104 million—ELC Broward began the new fiscal year with a modest awareness strategy and paused all paid promotion, redirecting limited funds toward VPK outreach.

In parallel, the team is continuing advocacy efforts by engaging key state legislators and municipal leaders who can champion increased School Readiness base or local match funding in future budget cycles.

Current Status:

Bookworms

We finished last fiscal year strongly, spending almost \$263,000 of our contract, which was amended/expanded from \$200,000 to \$275,000. This year, we begin the year with careful spending, due to budget cuts. We have spent approximately \$50,000. Our biggest spending period is the start of the school year, so we will now scale back to stay within our spending plan of \$100,000. Because the Bookworms program is easily switched back on, we are hopeful that we will be able to expand back to the original \$200,000 amount allotted to Bookworms later in the fiscal year.



Website Performance

Midway through Q1, landing page traffic is pacing similarly to last year across most service areas, with one key exception: our VPK page. VPK traffic is nearly double compared to this same time last year. This early performance suggests high interest and effective targeting heading into peak enrollment months. What this does not explain, of course, is the decrease in numbers of VPK enrollments year over year. That may be explained by a variety of factors, including decreased population of young families living in Broward.

Advocacy & Governmental Relations

We continue to strengthen our legislative and community engagement:

- State Rep. Marie Woodson (HD 105) partnered with ELC Broward to host a Childcare Provider Townhall on Thursday, August 28, 2025, at the Broward College South Regional Library. Rep. Woodson plans to put forward legislation that would potentially provide more funding in base allocations for Coalitions like Broward that consistently enroll, spending every dollar received every year.
- We are also coordinating with **State Rep. Christine Hunschofsky** to organize a childcare site visit on **September 9**th, **2025** to highlight the impact of early learning and School Readiness funding as both an educational investment and a critical workforce support.
- As part of our "Kindness Counts" Campaign, we are engaging VPK classrooms and municipal partners. VPK students will be encouraged to create artwork centered on the theme "What Kindness Means to Me," which municipalities may display during the month of October. Cities will also be invited to visit local VPK classrooms to reinforce the message of kindness to our young children.
- October 21–22: ELC Broward will host a Kindness Book Reading & Children's Activity in the ELC Model Classroom, with refreshments provided. Full event details will be included in the upcoming Board Engagement Package.

Community Outreach

Our summer outreach efforts wrapped up with participation in several community resource and back-to-school events. A highlight was the **City of Sunrise's Back to School Splash**, where ELC staff connected with three Sunrise commissioners and conducted an on-site interview with **State Senator Dr. Barbara Sharief**.
